A limited amount of financial assistance funds for travel, on a reimbursable basis, may be available for grass roots community representatives, tribal, and student conference participants. Financial assistance will be awarded based on available funds and equitable distribution. Funds will be awarded in accordance with the guidelines below.

Eligible Expenses:

- Hotel Room
- Transportation to Washington, DC and return home

PLEASE NOTE: The conference does not provide a per diem nor does it reimburse for travel in Washington, DC or meals.

Conditions for Receipt of Funding:

1. You must register for and attend the entire conference (no funding will be provided to persons not attending the entire conference).
2. Your complete application must be received by November 30, 2017.
3. To apply you must provide your name, address, organization, title (if applicable), email and phone number by email to: email@thenejc.org. Please also provide us a brief description of your environmental justice activities and interests. If a student, please include your major and the name and contact information for your department head. Please be sure to put "Scholarship" in the subject line.
4. You will receive notification of acceptance of your request by January 16, 2018. Only recipients of the scholarships will receive notification.
